County We the undersigned being two of the
overseers of the poor in and for the town of
Washington in said county do certify that
Winah a colored Woman and Slave to the heirs
of Isaac Smith deceased (who the executors
of the said Isaac are desirous to manumit
and set free) is of good constitution and under
the age of forty five years and of sufficient
ability to maintain her self and consent to
receive her the said Winah as an indentured
- ant of the said town of Washington given
under our hands this six day of February
1826
