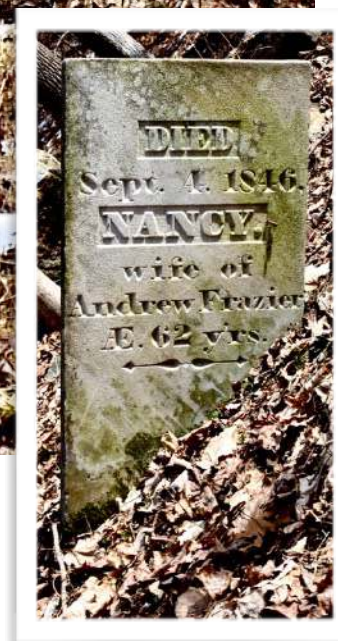


STANFORD

In this instance, headstones were allowed, although the section is clearly separate from the main cemetery. Some of the burials, such as the Frazier family, were listed in the county-wide 1924 survey of headstones by Poucher & Reynolds.
