Since 2018 and the commemoration of the 100th anniversary of the end of WW1 in 1918, the Dutchess County Historical Society (DCHS) has conducted a project to document the military experiences of veterans of all wars, with the support of Adam Roche, Director of Dutchess County Veterans Services. This project is enabled by a series of oral history interviews with volunteer veterans by DCHS veterans, and conducted throughout the county and kept in the on-line DCHS repository for current and future generations.
